The diverse offerings available at this event continue that tradition. This festival, at the colorful Georgetown Trailer Park Mall, features a diverse selection of boutique beer from Counterbalance Brewing, Elysian Brewing, Flying Lion Brewing, Future Primitive Brewing, Georgetown Brewing, Ghostfish Brewing, Jellyfish Brewing, Lowercase Brewing, Machine House Brewing, Perihelion Brewery, Seapine Brewing, and Tin Dog Brewing. Tickets redeemable for beverages are available on site (\$3 each or 10 for \$25). The festival is restricted to ages 21 and over with valid ID. Patrons are encouraged to make an evening of it with a

meal at one of our many fine dining establishments.

There was a need for a facility that offered indoor batting cages, as well as coaching for baseball and softball athletes for a reasonable cost in the Seattle area. Go Time Athletics has addressed this need with their athletic facility in Georgetown, right in the heart of Seattle.

If you are looking for an indoor facility for individual workouts or for your entire team Go Time is the place! No more need to drive 40-60 minutes to hit baseballs and softballs. Go Time's facility is right here at Orcas Business Park next door to the Seattle Wholesale Growers Market.

Go Time Athletics has brought together top baseball and softball coaches to provide lessons and to lead our camps and clinics. They provide clinics on a weekly basis and all of their coaches are available for private lessons. The facility has 6 batting cages $(15' \times 45')$ or 3 full length tunnels $(15' \times 90')$ for pitching and long toss throwing that are available for individual or team workouts. The cages will have retractable dividers when all pulled back the area can be used for team infield work. Individual cages can be reserved for \$40.00 plus tax per hour. Pitching machines are also available for rental.

Since opening in January 2019, they have also expanded into other sports including youth football, youth soccer, track, lacrosse, volleyball, dodgeball and more that have worked out of the facility. It is also a great event space for birthday parties and corporate events.
